STRONG DADS

LifeSpring is devoted to developing strong families. To that end, we know that dads have a very real impact on the lives of their children. Studies indicate a supportive, present dad reduces infant mortality and likelihood of a child's life in poverty. He can lower rates of psychological distress, lower rates of teen pregnancy, lower incarceration rates, and reduce the likelihood the child will be sexually abused. Just being present as a dad markedly increases graduation from high school and improves kids' behavior with their peer group. As the fatherhood ministry evolves at LifeSpring, it is becoming increasingly evident that beyond encouragement to continue the pregnancy, the male advocate is promoting successful fatherhood. We do this by initially meeting the father when they first arrive at LifeSpring to witness the first sonogram of their baby. We get to know their attitude towards the pregnancy, the nature of their relationship with the mother, understanding their vocation, and most importantly, what their faith background is. Given the opportunity to speak, these men uniformly are engaged and effusive in their sharing of their lives. We follow-up the meeting with a phone call or text, and seek to meet them for a meal to further encourage them.

During the coming year, we plan to initiate a lecture series based upon Brightcourse content that educates men on topics such as: taking care of her during pregnancy, birth, and postpartum; baby care basics for dads, being present for your child, how to lovingly discipline and showing love and encouragement.

We welcome your prayers and your financial support for a successful year ahead.

A NOTE FROM OUR BOARD CHAIR

If I told you that LifeSpring's mission to "provide services and abortion alternatives that empower mothers to choose life" may be even more critical now than BEFORE the 2022 Dobbs decision, would you believe me? Let's take a look. It's been about 2½ years since the Dobbs decision held that there is no constitutional right to abortion. However, Dobbs didn't end abortion in America, it merely returned the issue to the states, resulting in a hodge-podge of approaches. According to the National Right to Life, about 14 states fully protect the unborn child throughout gestation; whereas, about twenty-four states still allow abortions through at least 22 weeks, and even beyond. Other states are in between, such as Florida and Georgia, which protect the unborn child at six weeks under their "heartbeat" laws. As for Virginia, things remain the same. Virginia allows abortions up to 26 weeks 6 Days.

What does this mean for pro-life pregnancy resource centers such as LifeSpring, and your efforts to support us? Well, because we are in Virginia, our area offers something that the "pro-life" states don't have much of; namely, abortion clinics. Would it surprise you to hear that pro-abortion groups in the pro-life states actively seek to fund the costs for pregnant women to travel to states such as Virginia to obtain abortions? That's where LifeSpring comes into play. We have the ability to respond quickly and compassionately to abortion-minded clients who experience doubts and seek additional information and services (such as ultrasounds), even women who travel here from other states! When you heard about the Dobbs decision in 2022, did you think about this "out of state" possibility? I know I didn't! **But praise the Lord,**

because of your faithful support, LifeSpring has the ability to respond. What a blessing!

Thank you for all that you do, and for every day that you do it!

MEDICAL MINISTRY UPDATE

2024 has been a good year for the LifeSpring Medical Ministry! It has been a year of both adaptability and consistency. We have grown stronger as a ministry as we refine and adapt to the changing needs and demographics of our patients and the maternity leave of our Medical Director. We have been blessed by volunteer sonographers, a volunteer medical director, and many more who have risen to the changing needs of this ministry. We have adapted and updated our medical policy, protocol, and standing orders to best protect the durability of our ministry and provide consistent care to our clients.

Our medical ministry consistently has become a more integral part of achieving LifeSpring's vision of: "Life assured for every baby, hope renewed for every family, and lives transformed through Jesus Christ." We have learned that to effectively provide life-affirming care, we must address a woman's past, present, and future. We must not only care for her current situation and needs, but help identify past issues that influence her present decisions. Furthermore, we look to the future, by encouraging healthy behaviors, providing referrals and resources, prayer, education, and support. One important part of reaching women at risk of unplanned pregnancy is our Sexually Transmitted Infection Services program. Through this program, we have been able to identify and minister to women who are often open to the Gospel and ready for a new direction. We have been able to introduce concepts of spiritual health as an essential part of physical health.
